CSFP provides a monthly supplemental food package that includes:

- Cheese
- Canned meat
- Peanut butter or dried beans
- Cereal and grains
- Rice, instant potatoes or pasta

If you are eligible, you will receive a food package once per month of nutritious foods provided by the U.S.
